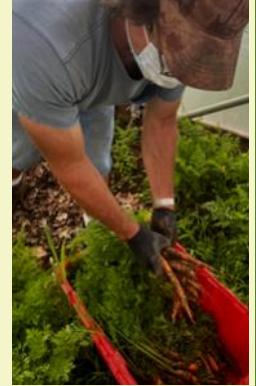


# Seton Harvest 2020 Year in Review
