Weekly Recipe: Grilled Leeks

Ingredients:

2 large leeks 1 tablespoon olive oil 1 tablespoon lemon juice
2 tablespoons parmesan cheese salt and pepper to taste

Directions:

- Trim and discard the tough top green part of the leeks and cut the rest into 4 in sticks, then cut each stick in half length ways.
- Run under water so all dirt is flushed out.
- Heat griddle pan or bbq grill until hot
- Brush leeks with oil. Place on hot griddle or bbq grill, cut side down to start. Cook on each side a few minutes until they begin to char or soften.
- Serve with a drizzle of lemon juice, sprinkle with parmesan and season to taste with salt and pepper.
